The Team arrived at Vunisinu Village around 11.10am. Peceli presented our 'i sevusevu' to the Village elders that were present.



VSIAF responded to a request from the Chairperson of the Navuvola Development Community Committee [NDC] based at Vunisinu, Rewa district. They requested for medical equipment to facilitate their dispensary. The village had their Annual Fundraising Day on Saturday -14.11.15 during which the handover took place.

The Village Community fundraised and built an extension to their Community Hall. The elders felt that since the village is located quite far from the Wainibokasi Hospital the need was there to build a dispensary to provide immediate medical care for the villagers.

The Senior Divisional Medical Officer Central, Mrs Alofa Fatiaki, opened the Dispensary, citing that the initiative has demonstrated a strong sense of ownership from the villagers towards their wellness. It has made it easier for the Ministry of Health's Community Services to do various medical

tests and consultations on patients with privacy. The village has approximately 200 people and will also extend its services to the other nearby village, Nalase.
